This quilt is suitable as a beginner project – squares, rectangles, half square triangles. The method for making the half square triangles in the pattern is a bit different than many of us use and requires being careful with bias edges. Karen will walk you through all the possible pitfalls and get you through at least one block successfully. You will need to pick up your kit in advance in order to Best Press (or starch) your fabric before the class.
